EXPERIENCE A LEGENDARY **PICKLE NIGHT** ONBOARD HMS WARRIOR!

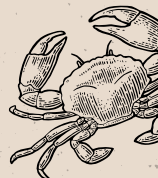

What is a Pickle Night?

Pickle Night honours the arrival of HMS Pickle, delivering news of the victory of the Battle of Trafalgar and the death of Admiral Lord Nelson. This festive occasion, observed around 4th November, celebrates the fastest ship at Trafalgar.

EVENT HIGHLIGHTS:

- **Entertainment:** Your host will bring to life the story of the Battle of Trafalgar by spinning dits and singing sea shanties. Audience participation is encouraged!
- **Traditional Dining:** Dine like the crew on authentic mess tables and enjoy a traditional two-course meal featuring hearty stews and stodgy puddings served with a choice of IPA or wine.
- **Audience Participation:** Play the part of your assigned crew profile whilst engaging in games, shanty singalongs and captivating stories.
- **Commemorative Toast:** Raise a glass in a traditional naval toast to honor the brave sailors of the Battle of Trafalgar. Don't forget to take home your special keepsake glass to remember the night.

GUN CREWS AND ROLES:

Attendees are organised into Gun Crews, each led by a Gun Captain Roles include:

- **Beer Bosun:** In charge of drinks.
- **Mess Cook:** Collects food for the crew.
- **Powder Monkey:** Assists the Mess Cook and conveys messages.
- **White Rat:** Spies on other tables and reports breaches of conduct.

ETIQUETTE AND FUN:

- **Master of Arms:** All proceedings will be lead by our host, the Master of Arms. He will set the evening's etiquette, communicated right from the start. However, don't get too comfortable as breaches in etiquette are reported by the White Rats and fined.
- **Dress Code:** White trousers, Blue and white striped top, Straw boater hat with (optional) HMS Pickle cap tally. Avoid pirate costumes - this is his Majesty's Navy after all!
